Northumbria Community Police visited in January to discuss knife crime with a number of students from **Grizedale** and **Kielder**. Students visited the Knife Angel located on Performance Square outside Sage, Gateshead. The 27ft tall sculpture is made from over 100,000 seized blades and was created to highlight the negative effects of violent behaviour. It symbolises a call for change whilst acting as a national memorial for victims of knife crime.
